NOTICE: C&S SHELLFISH: PORTAGE BAY AND LUMMI BAY ARE CURRENTLY SAFE FOR SHELLFISH HARVEST. BELLINGHAM BAY, BIRCH BAY AND DRAYTON HARBOR ARE CLOSED FOR SHELLFISH HARVEST DUE TO HIGH BIOTOXIN LEVELS. SAMPLES ARE TESTED ON A REGULAR BASIS, CHECK THE HOTLINE ON A REGULAR BASIS FOR UPDATES. NOTICE IT IS A VIOLATION OF SECTION 10.15.200 OF TITLE 10 TO HARVEST SHELLFISH IN UNAPPROVED AREAS PURSUANT TO SHELLFISH SANITATION REGULATION 2001. IT IS A VIOLATION OF THE LUMMI ORDINANCE TO SELL TO ANY BUYER NOT LICENSED BY THE LUMMI TRIBE. IT IS THE FISHER'S RESPONSIBILITY TO ENSURE THE BUYER IS LICENSED BEFORE YOU SELL OU

COMMERCIAL SHRIMP: COMMERCIAL SPOT SHRIMP AREAS 20A, 20B, 21A, 21B, 22A, 22B, 23A, 23B, 25A, 25B, 25D, AND 26AW EXCEPT THOSE PORTIONS OF 23A, 23B AND 25A SOUTH AND WEST OF A LINE FROM TRIAL ISLAND LIGHT (OFF VICTORIA, BC) TO VESSEL TRAFFIC LANE BUOY "R" (BETWEEN HEIN BANK AND DUNGENESS SPIT) TO THE POINT WILSON LIGHT. AREAS 1A, 1B AND 23A WEST OPENS FROM 7 A.M. TO 12 NOON FRIDAY, MAY 31 WITH 25 POTS LIMIT PER BOAT. AREA 1C OPEN FROM 6 A.M. TO 6 P.M. FRIDAY, MAY 31 WITH 30 POTS LIMIT PER BOAT. FISH I.D. MUST BE VALIDATED FOR SHRIMP. POTS MUST BE REGISTERED WITH FISHERIES. SPOT SHRIMP MUST MEASURE 30 CM FROM POST ORBIT TO THE DORSEL MIDLINE OF THE CARIPACE. MUST COMPLY WITH TITLE 10 AND REGULATIONS 2024-039. TAKE HOME SHRIMP MUST BE REPORTED ON FISH TICKET.

COMMERCIAL NON-SPOT SHRIMP IS OPEN. REGION 1; REGION 2 WEST; AND REGION 3 AREAS 20A, 20B, 21A, 21B CLOSES 5 PM MONDAY, MAY 27. AREAS 22A, 22B, 23A, 23B, 25B, 25D AND 26A WEST EXCEPT THOSE PORTIONS OF 23A, 23B AND 25A SOUTH AND WEST OF A LINE FROM TRIAL ISLAND LIGHT (OFF VICTORIA, B.C.) TO VESSEL TRAFFIC LANE BUOY "R" (BETWEEN HEIN BANK AND DUNGENESS SPIT) TO THE POINT WILSON LIGHT ARE OPEN AND CLOSES 5 PM TUESDAY, OCTOBER 15 OR WHEN THE TRIBAL SHARE IS TAKEN. RESTRICTIONS: FISH I.D. MUST BE VALIDATED FOR SHRIMP. MAXIMUM 100 POTS PER VESSEL. SPOT SRIMP CANNOT BE SOLD OR RETAINED. ALL HARVEST MUST CEASE AT CLOSING. POTS MUST BE REGISTERED WITH FISHERIES. BUOY MUST BE ATTACHED TO POT WITH FISH I.D. NUMBER WRITTEN ON IT. ALL NON SPOT SHRIMP INTENDED FOR PERSONAL USE MUST BE REPORTED ON FISH TICKETS AT TIME OF LANDING. MUST COMPLY WITH TITLE 10 AND THE CURRENT NON-SPOT SHRIMP REGULATION POSTED IN FISHERIES OFFICE.

COMMERCIAL SALMON: COMMERCIAL CHINOOK IS OPEN FROM 5 A.M. TO 5 P.M.; WEDNESDAY, MAY 29 TO THURSDAY MAY 30 AND SATURDAY, JUNE 1 TO MONDAY JUNE 3 IN AREA 7D AND THE PORTION OF HALE PASSAGE RUNNING FROM THE 7/7B LINE (POINT MIGLEY TO SANDY POINT) TO A LINE RUNNING FROM THE SOUTHERN POINT OF PORTAGE ISLAND TO SMUGGLERS COVE ON LUMMI ISLAND. FISHERS MUST CHECK IN WITH MICHAEL TO RECEIVE PERMIT BEFORE FISHING. MUST HAVE VALID FISH STICKER TO ATTAIN PERMIT. LUMMI BAY GEAR; TROLL, HOOK AND LINE, AND GILL NET (NOT TO EXTEND OUTSIDE 7D). HALE PASSAGE GEAR; TROLL ONLY. FISHER MUST CHECK OUT WITH MONITOR AND CATCH MUST BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR SAMPLING. ALL CHINOOK WILL BE MARKED BY LNR STAFF AND ONLY TAGGED FISH MAY BE BOUGHT OR SOLD. MINIMUM MESH SIZE 6 INCHES.

GENERAL DIVE FISHERY NOTICES:

COMMERCIAL HARVEST DIVING: REGULATION 2019-09, LUMMI NATION COMMERCIAL HARVEST DIVING STANDARDS, ARE NOW IN EFFECT. THE REGULATION STIPULATES THAT FISHERS PARTICIPATING IN COMMERCIAL HARVEST DIVING ACTIVITIES PERMITTED UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF THE LUMMI NATION MUST FOLLOW THE GUIDELINES SET FORTH IN THE FEBRUARY 2019 VERSION OF THE LNR COMMERCIAL HARVEST DIVING STANDARDS MANUAL. FURTHERMORE, A COPY OF THE MANUAL IS REQUIRED ABOARD ALL VESSELS PARTICIPATING IN DIVE FISHERIES. COPIES OF REGULATION 2019-09 AND THE COMMERCIAL HARVEST DIVING STANDARDS ARE AVAILABLE AT THE LNR OFFICE AND ONLINE IN THE DOCUMENT CENTER UNDER THE LNR HARVEST MANAGEMENT WEBSITE. OPERATORS AND FISHERS MUST OBTAIN VALIDATIONS AND COMPLY WITH ALL PROVISIONS OF TITLE 10. COMMERCIAL HARVEST OF SEA CUCUMBERS AND SEA URCHINS IS PROHIBITED WITHIN THE SAN JUAN ISLANDS MARINE PRESERVES. MAPS AND DESCRIPTIONS OF THESE CLOSED AREAS ARE AVAILABLE AT THE LNR OFFICE.

CLOSED UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE. DISTRICTS 3 AND 4: OPEN DAILY UNTIL 5 P.M. SATURDAY AUGUST 31 OR WHEN TRIBAL QUOTA TAKEN. HARVEST IS RESTRICTED TO DAY LIGHT HOURS ONLY. RESTRICTIONS: MUST OBSERVE REQUIREMENTS OF THE CURRENT SEA URCHINS REGULATION POSTED IN THE FISHERIES OFFICE.
